The state EMT course must meet or exceed the US Department of Transportation National Standard Curriculum for EMT. This EMT state course must have been successfully completed within the previous two years. Additionally, EMT candidates must hold a current CPR credential and have successfully completed a state-approved EMT psychomotor exam.
